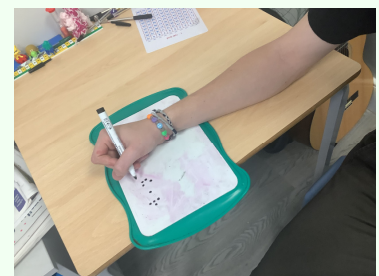
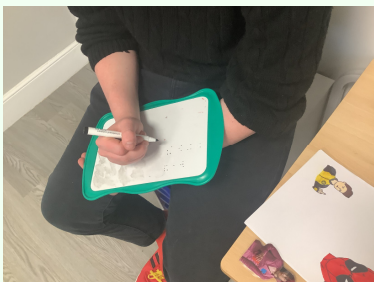
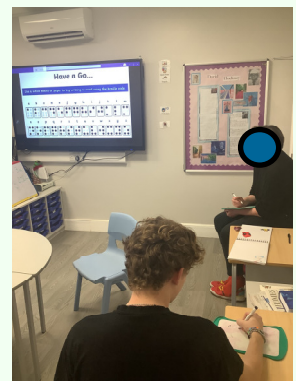
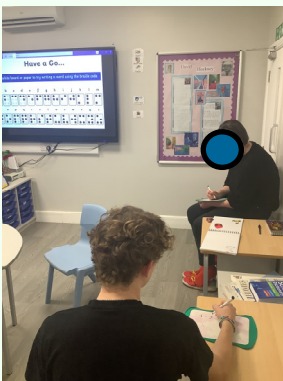


# Welcome back to school.

# History

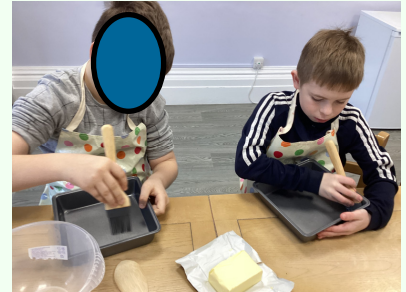


Students visited Peterborough Museum this week and saw lots of artefacts from the Stone Age during their private viewing with the curator.
