

Academic performance statement

At Oakham Shires School, we measure our pupils' educational success against their Education Health Care Plan Outcomes.

It is our aim that all children leaving us will have achieved an accreditation in Maths, English and Science plus two or three other areas of personalised study. The study routes and accreditation that pupil's access are appropriate to 'stage not age' and are tailored to suit the ability and needs of individual pupils.

Education Health Care Plan (EHCP) outcomes are set across the 4 areas of SEND; Cognition and Learning, Communication and Interaction, Social, Emotional & Mental Wellbeing and Sensory & Physical. All pupils will have long term outcomes set within these areas; each long term outcome will be broken down into short term targets designed to build towards achievement of the long term outcome.

At the end of each term we measure a pupil's performance against their short term targets; where short term targets have been achieved new ones are then set to build on these successes and move a pupil further towards their long term outcome.

When reporting pupils' performance against EHCP Outcomes it is the short term targets we are measuring.
